However, board and lodging may be provided free of charge during the period in which you remain a volunteer and you will be reimbursed for any reasonable expenses that you necessarily incur in the carrying out of your voluntary role. • A Uniform is provided by the FSC. • There is also a potential for part-time employment at the Centre in order to top up income.
